

MF wins "absolute champion in quality of ploughing" award in Serbia.

An MF 8270 Xtra with 5 furrow GB plough has won a 24 hour ploughing test in Serbia versus John Deere, Case and New Holland.

In 24 hours our drivers (customers) DRAGAN and MILAN TIKIC (father and son) completed 53,8 hectares. The depth was a constant 25 cm and the field looked perfect after ploughing. Fuel consumption was 18.7 litres/hectare.

The test is organised by the Farmers' Union, Faculty of Agriculture, Agriculture Equipment Society of Serbia and Montenegro.
